

**Board Paper 2013.2**

**Report on effects of Registration fee charged from CPRsouth Young Scholars and Paper presenter and funding rule on airfare**

Registration fees of USD 150 and USD 200 are charged from young scholars and paper presenter at the CPRsouth conference. The amounts were agreed during the 6<sup>th</sup> board meeting in Bangkok, Thailand. All young scholars and paper presenters were informed of this in the calls for young scholar awards and for paper proposals. However some of the participants requested waivers. The administrative partner granted 5 such waivers (3 young scholars, USD 450 and 2 paper presenters, USD 400). In addition to the registration fee we received USD 900 from the paid participants.

The total amount raised was USD 5150.


To Whom So Ever It May Concern
